## You Don't Have Because You Don't Ask – LEADER'S GUIDE

1. Thank everyone for coming.
2. Open in prayer
3. Read the focus passage.
4. Ask men to answer Question #1.
5. Listen to the program: "You Don't Have Because You Don't Ask"
6. After the program is finished, allow time for comments or questions on the program
7. Review the answers to the four remaining questions with the men in the group.  
Encourage everyone to participate, but never force or shame someone into participating.
  - a. Question #2 answer – children of God. (See Romans 10: 9 – 13, 1 John 3:1, Galatians 4:6)
  - b. Question #3 answer –
    1. They don't realize God wants them to ask.
    2. They have prayed before and they think God didn't answer their prayer.
  - c. Question #4 answer – "pray about everything."
  - d. Question #5 answer – We ask for selfish things for our own pleasure.
8. Ask the men what was most important to them from this teaching.
9. Ask men to commit to bringing their needs and the needs of others to God in their daily prayer time.
10. Confirm the time for the next meeting
11. Take prayer requests.
12. Close in prayer

Sample prayer: Almighty God, thank you for caring for us and allowing us to bring all our needs to you in prayer. Help us to bring our needs to you in our daily quiet times this week. In Jesus' Name, Amen.
